

Gold Bond and the Better Sleep Council Suggest...

Use a protective pad. A good quality, washable mattress pad is a must to keep your set fresh and free from stains (use one for the foundation, too, if you like).

Let it breathe. If you detect a slight "new product" odor, leave the mattress and foundation uncovered and well ventilated for a few hours. A breath of fresh air will do the trick.

Give it good support. Use a sturdy bed frame. If it's a queen or king size set, make sure your frame has the adequate center support that will prevent bowing or breakage.



Examples of proper bed frames for queen and king size bedding

Don't dry clean. The chemicals in dry cleaning agents or spot removers may be harmful to the fabric or underlying materials. Vacuuming is the only recommended cleaning method. But if you're determined to tackle a stain, use mild soap with cold water and apply lightly. Don't ever soak a mattress or foundation.

Turn regularly. Turning your mattress over and end to end every couple of months will help to equalize the wear and tear

that normally occurs. (While it is brand new "body impressions" may form, especially on extra plush mattress surfaces, which is normal. Turn every few weeks for the first few months to help smooth them out.) Occasionally turning the foundations from end to end is a good idea, too.

Don't remove the tag. Contrary to popular belief, it's not illegal to remove the law tag, but the information on the label will serve as a means of identification should you have a warranty claim.

Never apply direct pressure to the Boxspring or its border. It is meant to support broadly applied pressure from weight. Direct pressure will cause the springs or boarder to take a set.

Don't use it as a trampoline. Don't let the kids jump on your sleep set. Their roughhousing could do damage to the interior construction as well as to themselves.

No boards, please. Never put a board between the mattress and foundation. It may enhance the means of support for a while, but it will only make the problem worse over time. When any bed in your home has reached the "board stage," replace it.

Out with the old. Now that you've treated yourself to a new Gold Bond sleep set, arrange to have your old bed removed and disposed of. Don't give it to the kids, relatives, guests or neighbors. If it isn't good enough for you, it isn't good enough for anyone else. Consider it a health hazard.

Length of Warranty

Your warranty protects you from the day you purchase your sleep set and continues according to the "Warranty Schedule" found on the law tag attached to your new mattress and the corresponding codes printed on this card. In the event that we repair or replace your sleep set, this warranty continues your protection from the original date of purchase.

What is Not Covered

- Mattress Fabric (including stains, soiling or burns);
- Border wires, which run along the mattress and foundation perimeter, bent during moving or bending the sleep set;
- Structural damage from using an improper bed frame. This warranty applies to queen and king size mattresses or foundations only if they are used on an appropriate frame with a rigid center support having at least 5 legs or 5 hardwood cross slats;
- Clearance bedding sold "as is," and floor models;
- Bed height;
- Comfort preference;
- Body indentations less than 1 1/2";
- Mattress damage due to an inappropriate foundation. A

If identical materials are not available at the time of product service, Gold Bond reserves the right to substitute material of equal or higher value, or at our option, provide a refund. You'll be responsible for transportation costs of the product to and from the store or factory, as applicable.

Exclusive Remedy/Other Limitations

Any and all implied warranties on this product, including any implied warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular

purpose, shall not exceed in duration the term of this limited warranty which begins with the date of purchase by the consumer. The service terms stated in this warranty shall be the consumer's sole and exclusive remedy in the event of product failure during the warranty period. Please Remember the Following Points

Body impressions in a new mattress indicate that the upholstery layers are conforming to your body's individual contours. These are not structural defects but normal occurrences in the superior performance of the mattress.

Although it is not necessary to flip your new mattress to take advantage of the warranty, we recommend that you do so on a regular basis, about once every month. For your convenience, we've illustrated the best method:

Proper Mattress Turning Instructions



Step #1 Rotate mattress counter clockwise until it overhangs boxspring

Step #2 Raise mattress on edge and flip over gently

Step #3 Rotate mattress again counter clockwise and align with boxspring
